WALK 2

ALLT GOCH AND THE SEVERN WAY

DESCRIPTION A longer walk of some 4.5 miles through woodland, then along the Severn Way for a stretch before returning to Llanidloes along a quiet tarmac road. START Old Market Hall, Llanidloes.

- 1 From the Old Market Hall, walk along Long Bridge Street to the roundabout and turn LEFT over the bridge. Turn LEFT again along the B4518 signposted to Llyn Clwedog. After about 200 yards, turn RIGHT at the finger post for Glyndwr's Way and the Severn Way. Go AHEAD through the kissing gate and then bear LEFT, up through the wood at the point where Glyndwr's Way leaves the Severn Way. Follow the way marks for Glyndwr's Way to the golf course and bear right in front of the club-house, leaving the course via the gate and cattle grid onto the tarmac road.
- 2 After about 50 yards turn LEFT off the road, following the way marks for Glyndwr's Way and go through the farm gate AHEAD of you. Follow the track and stay on it past the point where Glyndwr's Way leaves the track to your left. Continue AHEAD through 2 gates and then follow the track through fields as it curves away to the right, through another gate and then down to the Llanidloes/Trefeglwys road. Cross the road and follow the way marks for the Severn Way as the track continues past a barn on the left and through fields, then along a lane into Cefnmawr farm. There are some nice views along this stretch.
- 3 As you go through the farm gate, bear RIGHT, keeping the buildings to your left and exit through another gate and along the farm track to the tarmac road. Turn RIGHT along the road and follow it down to it's junction with the Llanidloes/Trefeglwys road at which point you turn LEFT for about half a mile, re-cross the bridge and then turn RIGHT back to the Market Hall.
